Customers will be responsible for cleaning equipment in their own Kit Bag and for bringing it to class each week Some props may be shared intermittently at some classes, depending on theme. Once used, will be either cleaned vigorously before next use, or into Quarantine bucket for 72 hours.	Kit bags to be handed out at first class. These will be used for the duration of time that customers attend classes. Class Leader to remind customers to bring Kit Bag each week and clean them regularly.	Class Leader – hands out Bags once Remind customers weekly to ring Kit Bag and keep contents clean.

Advise parents that their children are their responsibility at all times and they should be keeping a watchful eye on them at all times.	Class leader – weekly (ongoing).
Access to Stage	Children at classes	Danger of falling off Stage	Use of stairgate. Class Leader to ensure this is in place and secure prior to start of class.	Inform parents / carers to ensure children are not allowed near Stage access.	Class Leader – weekly (ongoing).
